Countywide Competitive Teams Ages 8 – 14

Welcome to Lakewood Junior Baseball and the 2010 season. Lakewood Junior Baseball Association participates in the Jefferson County Junior Baseball League, JCJBL.

Team tryouts for all players ages 9-14 are scheduled for:

Saturday, February 6, 2010
Morse Park, 20th and Carr Street

Ages: 9, 11, and 13
Check in 8:30 a.m.
Tryouts 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Ages: 10, 12 and 14
Check in at 12:30 p.m.
Tryouts 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Rain/snow out date: February 13th
Weather permitting same location and times or indoors at Slammers if inclement weather.

Please check the Web site for additional information or inclement weather updates.

Registration fees for 2010 are \$165.00 and include a baseball cap, socks and use of a league jersey to be returned at the end of the season. Each player must provide their own baseball pants, glove, and cleats.

A minimum of \$90.00 is due at registration with the balance due on March 1st.

In addition, ALL players must participate in a league fundraiser or make a \$35.00 donation to LJBA in lieu of the fundraiser.

Player Placement Ages 9-14

Every player age 9-14 must attend tryouts with the appropriate age group to be included in the team selection process.

A Player's "baseball age" is determined by their age on April 30, 2010.

Players are allowed to "play up" one year at the request of the parents, AND if selected after tryouts by a coach for the older age team. Any player desiring to "play up" should try out with both age groups to protect a fallback position.

Players/parents may request a specific coach by writing in the special request section of the registration form. **Requests will be considered but are not a guarantee of placement.**

Ages 10 thru 14 must try out and should indicate whether they are trying out for a higher-level team or desire to return to their 2009 team.

Each player will be contacted and placed on a team within 72 hours after the completion of tryouts.

The regular season will consist of 18 games from roughly April through June.

T-Ball and Coach Pitch Ages 5-8

T-Ball and Coach Pitch teams will play approximately 8 games in a May – June season. Most games will be played on Saturdays. Players will be taught the fundamentals of the game to prepare to take the next steps in our competitive program.

Registration fees for the season are \$90.00 and include a LJBA game shirt, baseball cap, and socks **Fundraiser included in fee this year.** A minimum of \$50.00 is due at registration with balance due on May 1st. Each player must provide their own baseball pants, glove, and appropriate shoes.

There are no tryouts for T-Ball and Coach Pitch teams. Players are divided up and assigned to teams – 5 and 6-year olds play T-Ball, 7 and 8-year olds play Coach Pitch. **Requests will be considered but are not a guarantee of placement.**
